## Tips for getting started



Decide what you'll have fun doing. Is it something you're going to arrange, or one of the many organised challenge events held every year around the country?

Will you do it on your own, with family, friends or colleagues, or in a community group perhaps? Fundraising for Schnauzerfest should be enjoyable, roping in others adds to the fun.

#### **SET A TARGET**

Setting a target is a fantastic way to get going raising funds and to keep motivated. There's nothing quite like seeing donations come in and helping you get closer to it.

#### YOUR ONLINE FUNDRAISING PAGE

Create your own page on JustGiving.
This makes it super easy for people to support you and you to share your updates, progress and thanks!

#### **Setting Up Your Page**

It's easy and has good tools to help make your fundraising a success. Justgiving send us your donations directly so all you need to do is get people to support and donate.

- 1. Go to justgiving www.justgiving.com/schnauzerfest
- 2. Click 'Fundraise for Us" and follow the step-by-step instructions.
- 3. Make your page personal, add photos and tell people why you're supporting us.



## Making the most of online fundraising

Don't by shy about asking for support. Kind people are everywhere and want to help good causes that matter to somebody. So show them!



Share your page widely and regularly on social media. Remind people what you're doing and why it matters to you. Email to friends, family, colleagues and other potential donors. Say plenty of thanks!



Busy people don't always donate when first asked, intending to do it later, so remind them, especially close to your event.

#### **SPREADING THE WORD**

Talk about your fundraising regularly, wherever and whenever you get the chance.

Make use of social media. Post regularly, tell people about your training if you're doing a challenge, or give them news about Schnauzerfest so they can see why supporting you is a great idea!

Contact local press including radio stations -Twitter is a great way to tap into local news. Journalists love uplifting stories, they'll want to hear from you, news is what they need, put yours out there.

### DOG WALKS as fundraisers


Schnauzerfest began as a fundraiser doing dog walks. Now as a registered charity, we love it when supporters choose to raise money this way. Email us for more tips!

The key is to keep everything simple. Walk with a few friends. Choose a place you are familiar with. If the location is a managed one check dogs are welcome. Avoid one that's busy with other users.

#### **RAISING MONEY**

Email everyone and ask them to donate online. This avoids you needing to collect money on the day (see p14 for regulations that cover collections).

Post lots of photos on social media asking for donations.



#### **SAFETY ON THE WALK**


Be sure your friends are responsible dog owners when inviting them to join you. Keeping dogs under close control is required of dog owners by law. Dog theft is a risk which can be reduced by keeping dogs close and in sight at all times.

### Promoting your event

When you decide on your event tell everyone! Email friends, family and colleagues telling them why you're fundraising for Schnauzerfest. And stay in touch, especially at the time of the event and shortly afterwards. Many will donate then, especially if you've been sharing your news.



#### **EMBRACE THE ORANGE!**

Schnauzerfest is eye-catchingly orange, make the most of it in your promotional materials

Put posters up in local shops if you're allowed to.

We can provide you with your own fundraising logos to add to posters and marketing material, just drop us an email. Tell your employer - many will match fund what you raise, so worth asking.



## LEGAL & other useful bits

We want everything at your event to go well. Here's a few important things to be aware of. Your event will be in aid of Schnauzerfest which means it's your responsibility to keep it legal & safe.

Collections - if on private property you'll need written permission from the owner and have it with you when you're collecting. On public land collections require a local council licence, or Met Police if in London.

Collection boxes must display our logo which we can supply.

Raffles & prize draws are a great way to raise funds but they are covered by regulations. All tickets must be sold for the same price, no 2-4-1 offers, and you may need a local lottery licence. Please make sure you're staying legal.

Insurance - when you're running your event everyone needs to be safe. It's your responsibility to ensure this. Insurance is not always going to be needed. Your event won't be covered by Schnauzerfest's insurance.

Check if the venue requires any, some provide it. Depending on your event you may need to get Public Liability cover which can be obtained inexpensively.
